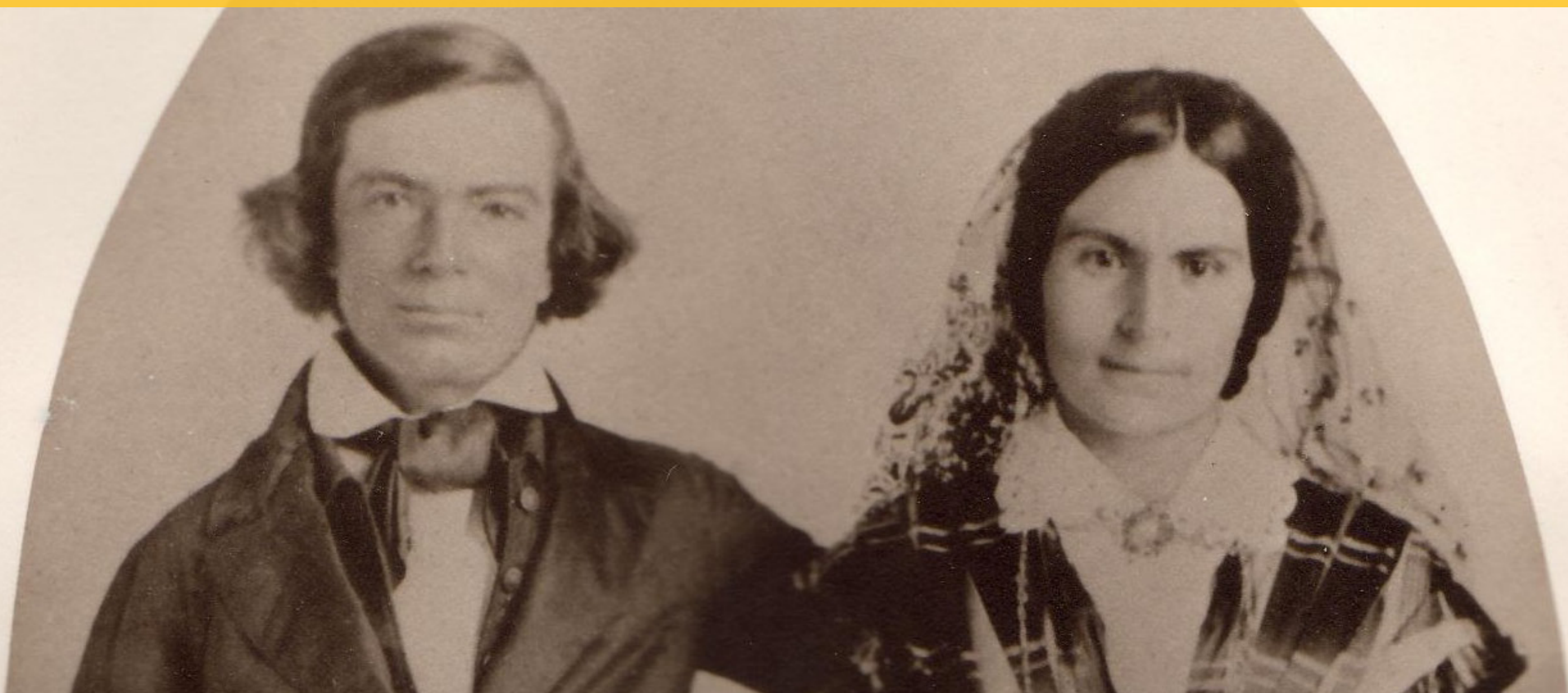


Moving to the Siberia of Mexico: The Workman & Temple Families & their Migration to Mexican California

After migrating first to Missouri, New Mexico, and Hawaii, William Workman and the Temple brothers, Jonathan and Pliny eventually settled in Mexican Alta California, once referred to as the “Siberia of Mexico.” Museum Director Paul Spitzzeri explores the stories of these migrants, including adaptations and conflicts as foreigners in the new Republic of Mexico headed to an inevitable conflict with an aggressively expanding United States.
